From its first days, our charity's mission was simple: bring a smile to a child's face, be it from a fun one-time experience, or supporting the purchase of specialized equipment that will enrich the child's daily life. We work with each individual and their family to deliver the wish that's just right for them.

It's okay to ask for help with practical needs to support a child – we're here to help.

We understand certain necessities may be more difficult to provide in challenging circumstances, and that there are gaps in the care system that we can help fill.

We keep the red tape to a minimum.

We realize how much paperwork families in these circumstances are already burdened with. Our intake system ensures full accountability. We try to make applying for wish funding an easy, relaxing and friendly process for everyone.

We need you to connect us with children and families that may need our help.

We rely on referrals from our community to help us reach as many children as possible. It's easy to refer a child on our website or by calling our office. Our contact information is on the back of this leaflet.

What is the effect of a wish?

Wishes are vital to a child with medical challenges. Amid a stressful series of hospital visits, X-rays, injections and medications, a wish brings a little happiness, some hope, and lots of smiles. This can replace anxiety and distress, and is a motivator to help families cope.

The anticipation of a wish can be as impactful as the wish itself. It builds excitement, provides a time to dream, and is a distraction from the daily grueling routines and challenges. We see the joy in children and their families when we talk about their wishes.

To be eligible, a child must:

- Be under the age of 19
- Reside in Guelph or Wellington County
- Be living with at least one of the following:
 - A rare, debilitating syndrome
 - A significant illness
 - A life-altering injury

We are a local charity that is 100% funded by our generous community.
